

19 August 2020 Meeting Minutes

The August meeting was held on the 19th with 15 members present. The club now has 38 paid members with the prospect of another one shortly.

The club is in good shape financially with a balance of \$3,081.73 after expenses. Contributing factors were that we didn't roll the field nor did we have a Spring Fun Fly. As mentioned before we will roll the field next spring.

The September Club Meeting will be on Wednesday the 23^{rd.} This also allows us to further discuss the Fun Fly just a few days prior and ensure everything is in good shape. We will also cover any other topics or concerns that pertain to the club.

We are having our Fun Fly on Saturday the 26th of Sept. The event kicks off at 9.00am with the main focus of everyone having a good time. Friends and Family are welcomed and encouraged to attend. Friends or Family that want to join the fun and fly certainly can just as long as they have AMA insurance. Rain date is the 27th.

Mower Shed – It was decided that we are going to go with building a wood shed approximately 8 by 12 feet in size and costing around \$1,300.00. We will also be looking at some kit's that supply the material to build one. Volunteers will be welcome during final assembly on location. More information will be forthcoming on this one such as the final decision and build dates.

There was a fair amount of discussion during the meeting over different skill sets that our members posses and how those skills can be used to help those that can use some assistance in these different areas. It was decided that we could put out a voluntary list with contact information so that others can contact them for any assistance as needed.
