- The mower has been serviced, is in very good shape, and should serve us well during the flying season. Unfortunately the same can not be said for the shed in which it is housed. Weather and time are taking its' toll, and the club should plan on replacing it in the near future.
- The pin box has been reset with some concrete, and should present no problems to us. The door still needs some minor adjustment, and Norris and Bill indicated that they will take care of this shortly.
- The Fun Fly is scheduled for Saturday, June 9th with a rain date of Sunday, June 10th. Members are asked to bring an item to the gathering. The club will have the dogs, hamburgers, sodas and condiments. Chips, snacks, diet soda, etc are always appreciated.
- The weather continues to delay the rolling of the field, and as soon as the forecast shows a 2-3 day window of clear skies this will be addressed. Ed Lopuski, Tony Rossetti and Mike Kraynyak will plan and coordinate with the rental center, and take care of the field. Looks like the week of June 4th will be most likely.
- At present the club has 35 members and the updated financial report shows a balance of \$2,037.99 in the treasury.
- Regarding the interest of the Boy Scouts in model aviation; the members felt that we should extend and offer to our contact to speak at the next meeting in June. This will give the club a better understanding of the desired outcome sought by the Scouts, and the resources required by the club to accommodate the program.
